

There are both theoretical and practical sessions. With workbooks provided on the first day, coaches are involved by making their own lesson planner and logbooks. The 4-day course is to be completed with an open book test.



Objectives

As an international representative body, the HKEF aims to provide assistant coaches with adult learning techniques to prepare riders for competitions in all Olympic equestrian disciplines by using the FEI Coaching System for the benefit of equestrian sports.

- Have a first-aid safety certificate (recommended)


Beas River Equestrian Centre (BREC)
